Safeguarding Compliance Required Policy Checklist

As part of the **ICU WSCC 2026** safeguarding requirements, all participants must complete the Safeguarding Compliance Required Policy by providing a criminal record check and Identification verification for everyone accompanying the team to the Warm-Up Room/Backstage – Athlete Areas. (Coaches, Assistants, Directors, Medical Staff, Federation Officials, etc.)

Please follow the steps below carefully.

1. Required Documentation (These documents will be used **solely** for safeguarding verification purposes).

To verify your criminal history and confirm your identity, you must provide **all** of the following:

- **Criminal Record Check**

- OR, for non-U.S. residents: a valid **Visa or ESTA**
- OR a **National Federation Membership Card** that confirms a completed criminal record check

- **Legal government-issued photo identification**

- **Passport-style headshot**

2. File Upload Instructions

1. Create a **shared folder** for your documents.
2. Upload the following items **together**:
 - Passport or government-issued photo ID
 - Passport-style headshot
 - Criminal Record Check (or approved alternative listed above)
3. Ensure the folder is **shareable** and grant access to **wsc@cheerunion.org**.
4. Your **digital event safeguarding cards** will also be uploaded into this folder.

3. GDPR Compliance

- All personal data will be **stored securely** and **accessed only by authorized personnel**.
- Your information will be used **solely for safeguarding and verification purposes**.
- Data will **not** be shared for any other reason and will comply fully with **GDPR regulations**.

4. Upload your FINAL Registration Invoice

Important Notes

- Ensure all documents are **clear, current, and legible**.
- Delays in providing proper documents may result in delayed verification.
